

Arkansas Governmental Manager (AGM)

The Arkansas Governmental Manager Program provides management and leadership skills training to middle and upper level managers in state and local governmental and nonprofit agencies. The AGM is attained by completing six two-day courses and an approved project plan.

Certified Public Manager® (CPM)

To further advance their professional development and critical thinking skills, AGM graduates are eligible to receive the nationally recognized Certified Public Manager® (CPM) designation by completing five additional courses, documenting 146 approved professional development hours, and successfully passing a comprehensive examination. CPM graduates are eligible for fellow status in the American Academy of Certified Public Managers®.

Certified Volunteer Manager (CVM)

The Certified Volunteer Manager (CVM) program was the first of its kind in the United States and is emulated in many other states. It fosters professional excellence in volunteer management by providing quality leadership training for managers and administrators of volunteer programs. Six two-day courses and an approved project narrative are required for graduation. APAC partners with the DHS Division of Volunteerism to provide this program.
