Tim Lampe, ASCPM President Elect and our luncheon speaker for June 1, is an Assistant Director with the Arkansas Department of Health and Human Services' Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education. The division has 175 employees and is responsible for a budget of approximately \$200 million that offers services for child care center/home licensing, family child care assistance, special nutrition, and early childhood education programs.

He is responsible for policy related issues; accountability and program compliance; and information technology development within the Division.

Lampe is a retired U.S. Air Force colonel and joined Arkansas State Government in May of 2003.

He is a graduate of the University of Minnesota and has three Master's degrees with concentrations in Business/Public Administration, Health Services Management, and National Resource Strategy. He and his wife Cathy live in Cabot, Arkansas.

AGM and CPM Graduates in Arkansas
